### SANCTUARY

## ADULT EDUCATION CLASSES

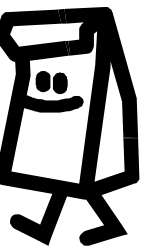

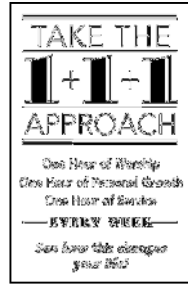
