### SANCTUARY

**Drop-In Bible Study** – 8:45 am Sundays, taught by Ron Reynolds. "Death and the Intermediate State" This section of our study deals with eschatology. This word is derived from the Greek word *eschaton*, meaning "last." The beginning of this study is a frank look at death. Death is the last enemy to be subdued by Christ. "If a man dies, will he live again?" What does death mean to the Christians? Paul's letter to the Romans explains the origin and current nature of death. Romans 5:14 asks, "Was there sin prior to Moses' law?" The answer is "Yes," because death existed, and without law there is no sin. Without sin there can be no death. Death is not a part of the natural order of things. It is a part of the fallen order of things. Feel free to stop by and join us!
