SANCTUARY

- There is a **Quiet Room** available in the back of the church across from the Nursery for families with infants and small children if needed.

ROCK (grades 6th-8th) meets Mondays 5:30 pm – 7:30 pm

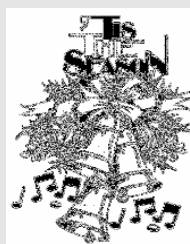
FISH (grades 9th-12th) meets Sundays from 7:30 – 9 pm
