SANCTUARY

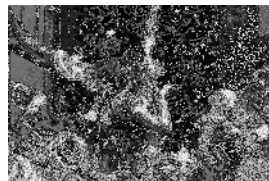
ROCK (grades 6th-8th) meets Mondays 5:30 pm – 7:30 pm

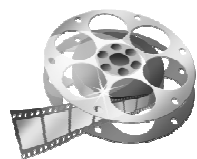
