SANCTUARY

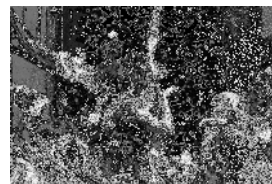
ROCK (grades 6th-8th) meets Mondays 5:30 pm – 7:30 pm

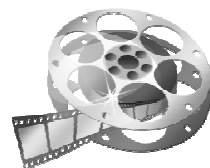

Drop-In Bible Study - 8:45 am Sundays, taught by Ron Reynolds. "The Presence of Christ" John Calvin always insisted that his debate with the Roman Catholics and Lutherans was not over the fact of Christ's real presence in the Lord's Supper but in the manner or mode of that presence. The Roman Catholics and Lutherans were both forced by their theologies to suggest a doctrine of ubiquity that Calvin believed to be in contradiction with orthodox Christology. How then did Calvin maintain a doctrine of the real presence of Christ without falling into a similar trap? In this lecture, Dr. Sproul introduces the Reformed doctrine of the presence of Christ in the Eucharist. DVD by R.C. Sproul.
