



COVID-19 Mask UPDATE

Evolving State and Local COVID Requirements

California and Orange County have now aligned their guidelines for mask usage with the federal center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). Masks, regardless of vaccination status, are now required in all indoor locations. Outdoors, those who are vaccinated do not need to wear masks or worry about social distancing. Those who choose to remain unvaccinated must wear masks, both indoors and outdoors, and maintain social distancing. This reinstated guidance covers everyone over the age of two.

In compliance with state and local guidelines, we now ask everyone to wear masks indoors while on church grounds. State and local guidance is very clear about the type of masking required. Masks must be at least two ply and cover both mouth and nose. Bandannas, single layer cloth or gaiter masks, visors, or shields do not meet state and local requirements for appropriate masking.

We are disappointed that we have to reinstitute these restrictions. We understand that there are many who disagree with the requirement, but state and local insurance and regulation guidance puts us in this unfortunate position of unpopular but necessary compliance.

We will continue to livestream all worship services. Hand sanitizer and masks will continue to be available at the entrance to LNPC buildings. Outside user groups are asked to ensure compliance of their participants.
